

Appropriate use of Cardiorespiratory Monitoring

Recommended

- “ When Apnea of prematurity unresolved by discharge date
- “ As part of discharge planning
- “ Enables doctors to manage discharged infants with conditions that may affect breathing, Heart Rate or O2 saturation
- “ Enables doctors to manage discharged infants who may have subtle or intermittent problems like cardiac conditions, seizures, parental neglect or abuse, or the onset of infections.
- “ When babies present in the ED with Higher Risk BRUEs

Not recommended

- “ In full term healthy infants
- “ When Apnea of prematurity resolved by discharge date
- “ When babies present in the ED with Lower Risk BRUEs
- “ As a strategy to prevent SIDS.
- “ Commercial baby monitors, not cleared by the FDA, should not be used
